





### **Burundi and Rwanda**

Pray for <u>Global Food Initiative</u> manager Jeff Boshart and volunteer Chris Elliott as they travel to meet with partners and visit agricultural projects in the African Great Lakes region. Their first stop is in Burundi to meet with Church of the Brethren partner organization Trauma Healing and Reconciliation Services (THARS) and its founder David Niyonzima. They will then visit projects and members of the Brethren Church of Rwanda, led by Etienne Nsanzimana. Jeff and Chris also will meet with leaders of Eglise de Freres au Congo (the Church of the Brethren in Congo). Pray for good health and safety for all involved. Pray for fruitful exchanges and meaningful fellowship.

### **United States**

Pray for Steve Van Houten as he begins work as interim coordinator of <a href="Brethren">Brethren</a>
<a href="Workcamps">workcamps</a> this week. He coordinated the workcamp ministry in 2005-2007, and he retired as pastor of Pine Creek (Ind.) Church of the Brethren in 2018. ### **Ethiopia**

Pray for all those who mourn the deaths of 157 people killed in the airplane crash in March. The victims were from 35 nations, with the greatest share (32) from Kenya. Nineteen of the victims were staff members of various United Nations agencies. One was working with the World Council of Churches. The cause of the crash is under investigation and more details are coming to light daily. Pray for God's comfort for those who grieve.

### Nigeria

Praise God for the work of volunteers from Ekklesiyar Yan'uwa a Nigeria (EYN, Church of the Brethren in Nigeria) who gathered in Kwarhi to mold 21,000 cement blocks for use in fencing the EYN Headquarters and Kulp Theological Seminary. More than 100 people from LCC (local congregations) Mararaba, Lumba, Kwagwang, and Kwarhi participated in the effort.



Pray for members of Ekklesiyar Yan'uwa a Nigeria (EYN, Church of the Brethren in Nigeria) and others in northeastern Nigeria who are facing an increase in violent attacks from Boko Haram insurgents. EYN officials report that people are living in fear and that many are relocating or sleeping in caves. EYN has requested specific prayers for church members who lost loved ones in an insurgent attack on the town of Madagali on March 1, when a suicide bomber entered the house of a church member and killed the family, and a rocket attack killed seven people. Pray for the congregation of EYN Bwaguma and the church members in the community of Gatamwarwa, which were attacked in February. The Bwaguma community's food stores were looted, and a seven-year-old was abducted from an EYN family, among other losses. Pray for strength for those living in grief or fear. Pray that the ways of peace may prevail.






