### **DISTRICT MINISTER TEAM NOTES**

### **Faith Working Through Love**

Annual Conference has always been a highlight of my ministerial year and this one held in Greensboro, North Carolina in 2025 was no disappointment. The theme for our 238<sup>th</sup> recorded conference had its highlights of excellent worship services, with outstanding music. The business meetings that allows any registered attendee to go to the microphones and share their feelings and opinions were very well guided by our Moderator Pastor Dava Hensley.

In addition to engaging with denominational agencies and programs for the regular reports, conversations, CODE meetings, there was the opportunity to sit-in two Standing Committee sessions dealing with the New Business items. They were considering queries coming to Annual Conference: (Standing Committee) from two different Districts. It was a wonderful time of seeing and meeting with old friends and making new family members.

Both of the nominees for Moderator Elect this year were friends and even though I did not cast a vote I would have been pleased no matter how it turned out. Pastor Dennis Becker from Columbia City Church of the Brethren, Northern Indiana District was called.

Attendance was 409 delegates and 916 non-delegates and 50 virtual individuals. These numbers continue to shrink and with the smaller numbers, smaller venues are ahead for us in the future. 2026 will be in Fort Wayne, Indiana June 28 through July 2, a Sunday through Thursday (something a little different).

Most Reports were submitted and passed with little or few comments raised from delegates.

The two Queries, considered new business, were the two items that created most of the discussion and took the most time on Friday July 4<sup>th.</sup> Approximately five hours was spent in discussion, amendments and heartfelt sharing.

After so much investment in time, New Business item: Concerns about Current Practices Related to Matters of Sexuality, was passed and sent on to the Review and Evaluation Committee. The New Business item: Reducing Harm: Interim Steps to Address
Sufferings, used the largest amount of time and overwhelmingly was heard but the 1983 paper on Human Sexuality continues to be our guide in a 300 to 37 vote.

Scripture still is our guide and we must continue to live in love and respect with each other, even with our differences.

We still stand in love, hearing the differences and living by the word of God and the Bible as our guide. Yes there are some who interpret things differently but our nature has been and hopefully always will be "No Force in Religion'.

Once again I observed the body of believers wrestling with differences but also discovering ways to live together. No one sin is more important than another and we strive together to live in Love and share Christ.

The **Annual Conference Wrap-Up** will share more about the 238<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference.



### ARBUTUS COB PET FOOD PANTRY

The pet pantry celebrated its second year of operation in May 2025. The pantry is open the second Saturday of the month from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. To become a new client the only credential needed is proof of your address. This can be any type of ID such as driver's license or a piece of mail with your name and address.

We collect donations of cat and dog food. If you have an open bag of food that is not needed it can be donated to the pantry. The volunteers repackage the food for the clients. These donations can be dropped off at the Arbutus Church of the Brethren 1201 Erickson Drive in Richland. The first set of doors of the church are open 24/7.

The pantry serves approximately 110 clients per month. Items placed on a free table are offered to the clients. Anything that fits on a table can be donated. We also have pet beds and climbers for cats which go quickly. In November the free table is offers blankets to the clients. Our goal is to collect 100 blankets for this year's table. 


