Global Mission Prayer Guide

Democratic Republic of Congo

We request prayers for DR Congo, especially North Kivu province after clashes between the M23 militia and Congo military in Bunagana. We also pray for the safety of our churches.

Haiti

Haitian gangs have blocked a major port, leading to fuel shortages. Clean water is also lacking, and there have been outbreaks of cholera. The United States and United Nations are considering armed intervention to support the national police. We praise God that construction continues, including a new church, as Haitian Brethren rebuild the community hit by an earthquake in 2020.

Violence and kidnappings continue. The US embassy has issued an alert indicating the possibility of terrorist attacks in Abuja, the capital of Nigeria and a region that had previously been relatively peaceful. We pray that the general situation may improve and for the upcoming centennial of the Church of the Brethren mission that established the Ekklesiyar Yan'uwa a Nigeria (EYN, the Church of the Brethren in Nigeria).
