

Garcia, our driver, helped us load the 4,275 pairs of shoes our churches and friends had donated onto the truck. The shoes are eventually loaded onto freight cars and shipped by rail to the **funDS2orgs** center in Orlando, FL for processing. Once again we were blessed to have great help with the shipment, since 171 bags of over 40 pounds each needed tagged and lifted into the truck. Clergy Tax Seminar 2024

January 27, 2024

11:00 am - 4:00 pm (EST)

Students, clergy, and anyone who deals with clergy finances are invited to participate in this online Zoom seminar.

- Learn how to prepare clergy taxes correctly and legally.
- Comply with regulations while maximizing tax deductions.
- Earn 0.3 CEUs - for the first 2 sessions only.

Schedule:

11:00am - 12:30pm EST (0.15 CEUs): Everything You Ever Wanted to Know About Clergy Taxation, part 1.

Topics covered: IRS's definitions of ministers (ministerial "status") and of ministerial work (ministerial "services"), as well as the three kinds of income ministers receive, the two kinds of taxes ministers pay, and the various ways ministers can pay those taxes during the tax year.

1:00pm - 2:30pm EST (0.15 CEUs): Everything You Ever Wanted to Know About Clergy Taxation, part 2.

Topics covered: Housing exclusion, parsonages and parsonage adjustments, and self-employment taxes, as well as ways to reduce total taxes.

3:00pm - 4:00pm EST: Completing the Clergy Tax Return.

Rev. Zeke Zacharias, pastor at Litlold Church, has a typical clergy tax return to complete. We will walk through it with him. Deb will be using H&R Block's Premium (for self-employed people) version of their downloadable software.

During this 5-hour webinar, you will learn a great deal about clergy tax law, tax preparation, and clergy compensation. It will be a resource-full day, so plan to take care of yourself as you learn. Eat when you're hungry. Get a drink when you're thirsty. Stand up and walk around when you need to. But most importantly, ask questions! If you have a question, Deb guarantees at least 6 other people are wondering the same thing!

Leadership:



Deb Oskin has been doing clergy tax returns since 1989, when her husband left seminary to pastor a small rural Church of the Brethren congregation. As a pastor's wife and later as a tax professional, she learned the tax problems and pitfalls associated with the IRS's identification of clergy as "hybrid employees." In 2011, after twelve years with H&R Block, Deb left to start her own tax practice, specializing in clergy taxes. Clergy clients now make up 86 percent of her client base.

Deb was ordained in 2004 when she was called by the Living Peace Church of the Brethren in Columbus, Ohio, to be their peace minister to the wider community. She served as Southern Ohio District's board chair from 2007-2011 and served as the Southern Ohio-Kentucky 2018 District Moderator. She is currently serving as Chair of the denomination's Pastoral Compensation & Benefits Advisory Committee.

She has been teaching and presenting nationally on clergy taxation to clergy, treasurers and administrators, and tax pros since 2004. Other than the fact that she really likes to teach, Deb does this because of her deep belief that clergy can devote more of their energy to ministry if they aren't stressed by tax debt.

Deb is an experienced presenter, and despite the complexity of the material, you'll find yourself laughing. Learn and enjoy!

Communication Skills for Pastoral Ministry

Class Description:

You've been called to the ministry, but the job requires more skill in speaking, listening, and writing than you possess. Don't worry! We've got a class for you. This revamped course in *Communication Skills for Pastoral Ministry* from the Susquehanna Valley Ministry Center will be geared, as much as possible, to the needs of individual students. Together, we will focus on the kinds of written and oral communication most often employed by pastors and other church leaders. We will use a variety of materials in print and online to address the need for concise, accurate language in church communications. Assignments will be in the form of short essays, letters, and reports. To complete the 15 hours required for the class, participants may be asked to join in an individual Zoom session or phone call.

Instructor Information:

Beckie Miller Zeek is a part-time minister at Bedford Church of the Brethren in Middle PA District. A graduate of the TRIM program, her first career was as a reading specialist in the public school system. She received her B.S. from Juniata College and her M.Ed. from Penn State University. She brings to the class 20 years' experience in ministry and 28 years' experience teaching reading and English to reluctant learners.


Church of the Brethren general secretary signs letter from Christian leaders to President Biden


