FROM THE DISTRICT MINISTER

On a "You Tube" video that I was watching recently, a teacher was challenging a Baptist church regarding

their lack of growth in numbers. He asked: "Do you have any evangelistic outreach programs? Are you personally sharing your faith with any one? Do you have any ministries to the poor? Any ministries to help people with addictions?" It seemed that the congregation was not actively doing these things.

As I listened to this teacher, it made me wonder if one of the reasons our congregations struggle with decline and smaller numbers is because we too are not doing these things. Are we stuck in a mindset that still expects new people just to show up at our churches on Sunday mornings?

The current statistics are that only 18% of Americans are actively engaged in the life of a local church. That means that there are a lot of our fellow Americans who need the good news of Jesus Christ. But it takes purposefulness and courage to take action to reach them with the good news.

Perhaps we feel tired or discouraged. Perhaps we are frightened by the negative attitude that so many people have towards "organized religion" and this makes us nervous about sharing our faith with anyone.

The good news for us is that the Holy Spirit can lift us beyond weariness and discouragement. He can help us conquer our fears and enable us to take steps to offer a loving witness to folks who need Christ.

Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Christ.

Acts 5:42

In the Book of Acts we read over and over how the power of the Holy Spirit moved the early church to effectively proclaim Christ and see new people added to their numbers.

This points us to the wisdom of our beginning to call upon the Holy Spirit for power for evangelism.

And then we must be willing to obey the Spirit as He would move us toward openly sharing our faith with those who do not believe. And it also means that our congregations need to evaluate whether we together are seeking the Spirit's guidance as to evangelistic programs that He would have us do.

It is indeed true that we need the Holy Spirit's empowerment in our time. Let us lift our hearts to the LORD and pray "Come, Holy Spirit!" Let us ask the LORD to fill us with faith and the Spirit's power for the necessary work of evangelism and caring for the poor in our neighborhoods. "Lead us, LORD!"





Church World Service Recovery and Support Kits

CWS Hygiene Kits, School Kits, and Emergency Clean-up Buckets are projects your church group can complete to make a difference for hurting people in the United States and around the world. These basic supplies are so common in the US, but so vital if you have lost everything in a disaster or live in poverty. Cash donations in lieu of assembled Kits or Buckets also help provide muchneeded supplies. If you have questions, please call the CWS Regional Office at 1-888-297-2767.

Wrap your love and prayers in every Kit or Bucket you put together. But, please, include only the items listed. **Do not include personal notes, money, or any additional items in or with the Kits.** And, please, do not include or decorate your Kits with religious symbols, as the Kits are shared with people based only on need, regardless of religion. Thank you for helping CWS be ready to respond!

Hygiene Kit

- 1 hand towel 16"x28" (no fingertip or bath towels)
- 1 washcloth
- 1 wide tooth comb
- 1 metal nail clipper
- 1 bar of soap (bath size in wrapper)
- 1 toothbrush (in original packaging)
- 6 band-aids

Place all items in a one-gallon plastic bag with a zipper closure, remove excess air from bag and seal. <u>Please do not add toothpaste to the Hygiene Kit</u>. Cartons of toothpaste that have an extended expiration date will be added to Hygiene Kit shipments just prior to shipment.

School Kit

- 1 30-centimeter ruler (12")
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener
- 1 pair blunt scissors
- 3 70-count spiral notebooks or notebooks totaling 200-210 pages. (No loose-leaf or filler paper.)
- · 6 new pencils with erasers
- 1 large eraser
- 1 box 24 crayons (only 24)
 - 1 12"x14" to 14"x17" finished size cotton or lightweight canvas bag with cloth handles. (Please, no reusable shopping bags or backpacks.)

Emergency Clean-up Bucket

- 1 Five-gallon bucket with re-sealable lid
- 5 scouring pads
- 7 sponges, assorted sizes
- 1 scrub brush
- 18 cleaning towels (reusable, like Easy Wipes®)
- 1 50-78 oz. box dry laundry detergent
- 1 12 oz. bottle of liquid concentrated household cleaner (like Lysol®)
- 1 24-28 oz. bottle liquid disinfectant dish soap (like Dawn®)
- 1 package of 48-50 clothespins
- Clothesline, 2 50 ft. or 1 100 ft.
- 5 dust masks
- 2 pair latex gloves (like Playtex®)
- 1 pair work gloves
- 1 24-28-bag roll of heavy-duty 30-45 gallon trash bags (may be removed from carton)
- 1 6-9 oz. bottle of insect repellent (pump, drops or lotion, note aerosol)

Please provide all liquids in new, unopened plastic bottles. **Be sure to send only new materials**. Place all items in the plastic bucket, making sure they are packed securely to avoid damage during shipment, and seal lid with packing tape.

Don't forget to send a check for \$2 per Kit or \$3 per Bucket to help cover the shipping costs.

Kits should be **securely boxed and taped**. Boxes should be packed with only <u>one type</u> of Kit (Hygiene, School, or Baby) inside each box. The boxes should be labeled, noting the type of Kit, number of Kits, congregation/group, contact person, address, and number of boxes. **Please DO NOT put the \$2 inside the kit.**





Haiti

Nurses and Agronomists working with the

Church of the Haiti Brethren's Medical Project (HMP) are teaching women and youth to grow vegetables.In rural villages, mothers of children two years old under and meet monthly with communi-



ty health nurses.

South Sudan

A grant of \$5,000 from the Global Food Initiative (GFI) was added to a \$24,500 allocation from the Emergency Disaster Fund to support agricultural development, trauma healing workshops, and emergency food distributions in South Sudan. GFI funds will go specifically to establish a demonstration orchard with fruit species including avocados, mangos, citrus, pineapples, bananas, pears, apples, and plums.

Uganda

The Church of the Brethren in Uganda is the recipient of a \$5,000 grant for the purchase of a grain mill and a structure to house the unit. Ugandan Brethren leaders plan to train 500 participants in the production of maize flour products, offer micro-financing, seed, fertilizer, and marketing support.

Nigeria

The agriculture department of Ekklesiyar Yan'uwa a Nigeria's Integrated Community Based Development Program (ICBDP) is now into its fourth year of promoting soybean as both a cash crop and protein-rich source for home

consumption.

Their goal for 2021 is to reach over 4,000 new farmers.

Last week as my sons and I were driving to church, my sons were being very hateful towards one another. I did not respond well either as a mom. I cried out to God because we were all just ugly. We needed His help. Anyone relate?

In that moment of ugliness, I felt such conviction. I started crying. Crying for my sin, crying for the sin sick world. Ugly is happening all around us. What a year it has been to be revealing that. I need to turn to Jesus. The world needs to turn to Jesus. He is the Prince of Peace and Light in the Darkness.

As a mom, I can see the confusion, the anger, the lack of purpose in this young generation. In part because my generation is confused and angry with lack of purpose themselves. The world needs revival. This younger generation needs hope in Jesus. They need a fun place to grow, to find and cultivate friendships, to find purpose.

Camp provides just that. We are here to proclaim hope in Jesus' name. We are here to offer kids a place to find meaning, find peace. Camp is a place to belong. As we as a nation try to get back to "normal" camp is more necessary than ever before. Kids and teens have been on devices, isolated.

As I reflect on what God has done the past year at Camp Harmony I am in awe. We are thankful for His provision through staff, volunteers, and financial donors like you. We are expectant that God will continue to do His work here at Camp Harmony. As of now, we have over 300 kids signed up for camp this summer and we expect that number to increase! We also have multiple church groups hosting their summer camps at camp this summer. We are super excited to be a part of this ministry.


