Looking down the road and waiting expectantly is as old as time. Humankind is looking and unfortunately worrying about just about everything. It even happens in our congregations.

The other day I heard someone say "Worrying is a negative prayer," I do not believe I had ever heard that stated quite like that before. I have told my children and myself that, "worrying is like paying interest on a loan you had not received yet," So often we worry about medical, financial and even spiritual matters, way before they even happen.

Parents and even expectant parents worry about how they will be able to pay for college or what occupation their child will go after and will they be able to afford a home when they marry. Some individuals worry growing old and how will they manage a wheel chair or walker! Really! In your thirties you worry about that?

Congregations worry about leadership, finances and buildings. Who will bury us, visit us or speak on Sunday mornings, and how does a small declining congregation maintain this building built a hundred years ago for 10 or 20 times the number that is attending now. Worry is a Negative Prayer! This idea that by watching and worrying we can affect or protect ourselves from the vagaries of life is untrue.

Trusting in God is more than a BUMPER STICKER, it is the path for success. Individuals and Congregations need to trust in God's plans and be willing to ask for the plans, and follow the plans God lays in their laps. Why would anyone who purchased a large multi passenger vehicle for their large family, continue to drive it, patch it, when you were down to two individuals or one?



Often family homes that once housed everyone growing up are moved out of, to a place that suits the needs of those remaining. It's more efficient and financially sound for those who are present.

I am constantly surprised at those who worry about how the church wants to change. They do not want to do it differently than how they have done it for the past xx years. Yet almost none have a Black and white TV, Rotary dial phone or live without a Microwave in their home. But live in the sixties in the church they sometimes attend and want everyone to go back in time, with music, dress and culture.

Serving Jesus in the present is where it needs to be, not worrying about how the culture, and the times have changed around us. In Matthew chapter 4 Jesus hears that John the Baptist is in prison, He then goes to Galilee. Then in Matthew 4:17: Jesus begins to preach; "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven has come near."

We need to quit worrying about what is down the road.

We must live out The Father's plan and move forward, not tied to the past, nor worrying about what is to happen. Live each day, each season and move faithfully toward the place prepared for the children of God. Worry is a Negative Prayer. Live in the light and promise of Jesus Christ. Remove the chains of the past.



PASSOVER SEDER

The Messiah in the Passover Banquet is a wonderful presentation that opens up the Old Testament and gives Christians new insights into communion. The Banquet will be approximately 2 and a half hours featuring a full Jewish Seder meal and explanations of the traditions presented. The presenter is **Jeff Kipp** from Chosen People Ministries.

Jeff was born Brooklyn, New York. In the Fall of 1973, Jeff left college, friends, and everything behind to find America and find himself. He landed in a little New Mexican town called Taos and the second day there, he was led to a Jesus People coffee house and met Dr. Michael Silverburg, a fellow Jew and fellow New Yorker. That night was the first time Jeff was told

that Jesus was the Jewish Messiah and he prayed to

receive Him into his heart and life. The Lord began to speak to Jeff of his destiny and the call of God upon his life in regards to reaching his Jewish people with the gospel. It was also in Northern California that he met his wife-to-be, Kathy. The Lord had led her to Santa Cruz to be a part of Youth with a Mission. They were called by the Lord to move back to Kathy's hometown of Minneapolis to begin their new life together. It was there they were introduced to the Messianic Movement and became part of a Messianic Jewish Congregation.



After many years of ministry, the Lord called the Kipps to relocate to Pittsburgh in 1993 where they have successfully pioneered and planted two Messianic Congregations and have seen many Jewish people come to faith in their Messiah. They lead Congregation Yeshua Ben David, started in 2005 and meet in the heart of Pittsburgh's Jewish community, in Squirrel Hill.

This event is open to people of all ages and families are encouraged to attend and be part of this experience.

I have only touched on the list of books and teaching resources available to borrow. Be sure to check our district resources!



Brethren Disaster Ministries responds to earthquake in Turkey and Syria

Church of the Brethren Newsline February 11, 2023

"Please continue to pray for survivors in the affected areas [of Turkey and Syria] who face the trauma of losing homes and loved ones, continued aftershocks, living out of doors without basic amenities/food and in freezing temperatures, and in danger of diseases such as cholera. Their needs are great and will continue to be great for a long time to come. Please also pray for all the official and unofficial responders." Brethren Disaster Ministries lifting up the earthquake crisis in Turkey and Syria, in a Facebook post on Friday, Feb. 10. Brethren Disaster Ministries staff are exploring how to support partners directly on the ground who are already meeting the needs of survivors as they can. The staff are working to be "as strategic as we can in



making sure that the funds we send go where they are most needed and where needs are not being met."

On February 10th, grants totaling \$50,000 were approved for two partner organizations, given from the Church of the Brethren's Emergency Disaster Fund (EDF): \$25,000 to support the Lutheran World Relief shipment of supplies to Turkey for emergency earthquake relief, and \$25,000 to support the Lebanese Society for Education and Social Development earthquake response program in Syria.
