153rd Annual District Conference Wrap-up

The delegates and non-delegates of the Western PA District gathered at Camp Harmony on October 19, 2019 on a beautiful autumn day for the 153rd Annual District Conference. Many thanks to the staff at Camp Harmony for all their help and hard work which made this District Conference a great day for all.

The Conference theme for this year was "All Scripture is God Breathed" from 2 Timothy. District Moderator John Stoner reflected on this theme and call to biblical accountability in his Moderator's Challenge.

There were 2 insight sessions in the afternoon, a short video presentation from the COB Mission and Ministry Board and "Calling the Called", a information session conducted by Pastor Cheryl Marszalek. All conference attendees were also encouraged to visit the exhibits area and browse through all the information presented by District Women's Ministries, Bethany Theological Seminary, Camp Harmony, Brethren Volunteer Service, Brethren Disaster Ministries, SVMC, Gideons, and Wycliffe Bible Translators. They were also invited to review and purchase items from the Brethren Press.

The Licensed Ministers of the District were consecrated by Pastor Gary Green representing the District Pastor & Parish Ministry Team. Stephen Parfitt and Daniel Rhodes also received certificates from Donna Rhodes from SVMC for work completed.

Cheryl Marszalek from the Uniontown congregation was installed as Moderator for 2020. James Hayes (Scalp Level); Robert Grafe (Moxham); District Treasurer, Carol Walker (Somerset); Assistant District Treasurer, Mike Seganos (Maple Spring); Standing Committee, Joe Brown; District Leadership Team: Outreach & Service Team, Karen Nagyvathy (Maple Spring); Pastor & Parish Ministry Team, Irvin Ernst (Hostetler), David Crable (Connellsville); Stewards & Finance Team, Terry Lyons (Windber), Mary Libengood (Meyersdale), Esther Bennet (Montgomery)

A budget of \$173,200 for 2020 was approved. The total reflects a \$10,603.00 increase. There were officially 185 attendees (164 delegates, 21 non-delegates) and 50 congregations were represented. The District Van was filled with hygiene kits, school kits, and clean up buckets for Church World Service. Thanks to everyone who gave so generously!



The Global Food Initiative works with multiple partners on projects such as this multi-crop thresher. Researchers at the University of Missouri, with metal workers in Ghana, developed plans for a multi-crop thresher for the Soybean Innovation Lab. A prototype recently was built by Sunnyburn Welding (Airville, Pa.), in conjunction with Harvest Chapel Mission (Bel Air, Md.). Upon completion of final adjustments, the thresher is bound for the Dominican Republic for testing with Dominican Brethren farmers. The long-term plan is for more threshers to be built in country and potentially sent to Haiti. Design plans also have been sent to Nigeria.





Earlier this year, deacons from Eglise des Freres du Congo (Church of the Brethren in Congo) gathered in Uvira, South Kivu Province, to participate in a workshop led by staff of World Relief, supported by a grant from the Global Food Initiative. Participants engaged in Bible study each day as a basis for conversations on the holistic mission of the church. Church leaders were encouraged to think deeply about topics such as development and poverty from a biblical perspective.
