DISTRICT CONFERENCE RECAP

The delegates of the Western PA District gathered at Camp Harmony on October 21, 2023 on a cool autumn day for the 157th Annual District Conference. The Conference Moderator Ron Beachley chose the theme Bind Us Together as the theme for this year's District Conference.

Conference was condensed into a morning business session followed by a delicious lunch served by Camp Harmony. There was also a brief presentation by Traci Rabenstein from the COB Ministry and Mission Board and a few short video presentations from the Church for the Brethren.

The Licensed Ministers of the District were consecrated by Pastor Irvin Ernst representing the District Pastor & Parish Ministry Team.

Jeffery Fackler from the Penn Run COB was installed as Moderator for 2024. Others affirmed on the slate include: Moderator Designate, Amelia Derr (Pleasant Hill) Program & Arrangements, Tammy Hoover (Salisbury); Camp Harmony Board, Todd Shaffer, Jim Rose, and Kelsey Duray; Gifts Discernment Team, Wayne Bowman (Hostetler); District Treasurer, Patti (Meyersdale); Assistant District Treasurer, Gerald Smith (Pleasant Hill); District Leadership Team: Outreach & Service Team, Marsha Smith (Pleasant Hill), Teresa Wolf (Pleasant Hill); Pastor & Parish Ministry Team, Glenna Bloom (Greenville); Spiritual Formation Team, Kaitlyn Coughenour (Hostetler); Addie Lucatorto Samaritan); Stewards and Finance Team, Donna Smith (Pleasant Hill).

Moderator Ron Beachley shared an official acknowledgement of the congregations that have left the Western PA District in 2022 and 2023.

Pastor Abby Shaffer shared a report from the District Search Committee, sharing all the work the committee has been doing over the last year. She then shared the recommendation from the committee regarding the proposed 3-person District Ministry Team.



The business item of changing the District Minister position from 1 person to a 3-person team in the District Constitution was approved by the delegates.

A budget of \$137,660.00 for 2024 was approved. The total reflects a \$4,102.00 decrease.

There were officially 100 attendees (80 delegates, 20

Non-delegates, and District Leadership and Staff) and 30 congregations were represented. The District Van was filled with hygiene kits, school kits, and clean up buckets for Church World Service.







Church of the Brethren and the Office of Peacebuilding and Policy join ecumenical and interfaith calls for ceasefire in Israel and Palestine

The Church of the Brethren has joined more than 20 Christian churches and other faith-based and peace and justice groups in sending a letter to the US Congress, dated Oct. 12, mourning the loss of life in Israel and Palestine and calling for a ceasefire and the release of all hostages.

The denomination's Office of Peacebuilding and Policy signed an interfaith letter to the Biden administration and Congress, dated Oct. 16, also calling for a ceasefire. The interfaith statement was led by prominent Christian, Muslim, Jewish, and Arab-American groups, and condemns all violence against civilians by Hamas and the Israeli military.


