Our last shoe shipment to funds2orgs netted over \$1,500 for the orphanage in Honduras! Thanks again to everyone who was able to participate in the program.

We have started collecting shoes, sandals, boots and slippers at the ICA building in Jerome in hopes of having enough gathered for a shipment again next spring. We are off to a good start, with over 500 pairs packed and ready, but we have a long way to go and need your help to reach our goal of 2.500 pairs of shoes.

CWS KITS

CWS Hygiene Kits, School Kits, and Emergency Clean-up Buckets are projects your church group can complete to make a difference for hurting people in the United States and around the world. These basic supplies are so common in the US, but so vital if you have lost everything in a disaster or live in poverty. Cash donations in lieu of assembled Kits or Buckets also help provide much-needed supplies. If you have questions, please call the CWS Regional Office at 1-888-297-2767.

Wrap your love and prayers in every Kit or Bucket you put together. But, please, include only the items listed. **Do not include personal notes, money, or any additional items in or with the kits.** And, please, do not include or decorate your Kits with religious symbols, as the Kits are shared with people based only on need, regardless of religion. Thank you for helping CWS be ready to respond!

Kits can be brought to the District Office during regular business hours or can be brought to Camp Harmony on October 16, 2021 during District Conference.

Don't forget to send a check for <u>\$2 per Kit</u> or <u>\$3 per</u> <u>Bucket</u> to help cover the shipping costs.

Kits should be *securely boxed and taped*. Boxes should be packed with only <u>one type</u> of Kit (Hygiene, School, or Baby) inside each box. The boxes should be labeled, noting the type of Kit, number of Kits, congregation/ group, contact person, address, and number of boxes. **Please DO NOT put the \$2 inside the kit.**



In September 2018, we began collecting gently worn, new, and used shoes in a creative shoe drive for Funds2Orgs (www.funds2orgs.com) as a way of raising funds for the **Enmanuel Children's Home in Honduras**. Funds2Orgs is an organization that purchases the used shoes, refurbishes them and then uses the shoes to help establish and supply inventory for small businesses in third world countries. They pay organizations like ours at \$.40 a pound to replenish their stock. We, in turn, donate the money we receive to help Hogar Enmanuel.

Since we began those shoe drives you, our supporters have donated 17,340 pounds of used shoes which translates to a whopping \$6936! So this is win-win for everyone involved.

This shoe drive is an ongoing project so we are counting on you to continue to give us those shoes you no longer want. Donations can be accepted at the Western PA COB District Office or call to schedule a time to take directly to our storage facility.

(Note: This project is a separate and totally different program from the TOMS SHOES™

Program that is conducted in Honduras.




