PASTOR APPRECIATION


Pastor Appreciation Sunday, October 8, is the special day of recognition for church pastors. It started as a Hallmark holiday dating back to 1992. At least one day per year the congregation as well as individuals might be aware of their pastor and show some gratitude for all that they do.

A pastor's role is quite unique, and we often do not appreciate what is done until we need services for a wedding or a funeral or etc. Even "part-time" Pastors are involved in the emotional, mental and spiritual challenges of their congregation or flock.

It isn't like hammering nails, or changing oil, or drawing up contracts. At the end of the task Pastors don't just go home and not think about the task again. Pastors go home and pray, and dwell on our concerns, caring for what the flock or individuals are going through.

Some congregations find interesting and thoughtful ways to appreciate their Pastors. October is Pastor Appreciation month. Let's be gracious with our love and appreciate your pastor all year. When was the last time you shared a compliment or just even a heartfelt handshake and smile with the pastor? Do it this Sunday, why wait!



Leadership in Turbulent Times Fall Book Study on Quietly Courageous: Leading the Church in a Changing World


God calls certain people into leadership in the church. And those that respond to that call are passionate about leading with purpose and care. Yet many pastors struggle to respond to the challenges of a changing culture, while remaining faithful to an eternal Gospel message. They recognize that leading a congregation isn't the same as leading a civic group or business, yet realize that people often interact in predictable ways. Gil Rendle, in his book Quietly Courageous: Leading the Church in a Changing World, offers insight for church leaders who want to lead well, and respond to the unpredictable forces that shape our world with grace and courage.

"Quiet courage is needed when there is no going back because the 'back' that is remembered doesn't exist anymore. Our current reality is that we are not in a turnaround situation. Leaders cannot take us back to a more comfortable time when the church was established at the heart of the culture as a bedrock, trusted institution."
